In case you didn't receive this postcard from the Legacy Theatre... **PLEASE READ!** This announcement also appeared in the Branford Eagle of 12/17/13.

"New Owners Have Big Plans for Stony Creek Theater" A 5 pg. article in the Branford Eagle 12/17/13 are plans for the Puppet House and 132 Thimble Islands Rd. (yellow house). 132 will be remodeled to include their offices. **Copies of the Branford Eagle at Library Reading Room.**

On 11/20/13 the Legacy Theatre applied for a building permit to install a new septic system for the existing theatre that will be renovated, and for the interior of 132 that will also be renovated as a one bedroom home.

At the January 7, 2014 Stony Creek Association meeting Mr. Knudsen, Legacy President and husband of Keeley confirmed 132 will be then rented as a home not their office.

There are still no parking facilities for the theatre. At the SCA December 2013 meeting, Keeley Baisden Knudsen requested that the Board ask the church finance committee if it would be possible for them to put aside parking spaces for the theatre, and what would they charge.

The important question here and now is: Do you want a 120 seat year round theatre that will include training in play-writing, acting techniques, and speech.

The Legacy group states it needs 1.4 million dollars to renovate the Puppet House as stated in the Branford Eagle.
