Dear Chief Halloran:

As chairperson for Police and Traffic on the Stony Creek Association my committee is requesting that striping be reviewed for change and parking in Stony Creek. The first area is west and south of the Stony Creek Memorial Green to allow parking for cars in as many spots legally allowed.

The second is that the "no parking" in the turn around at the dock facing west and entering the load unload zone be changed to Load Unload Ahead! Hopefully to prevent vehicles from parking in the turn around.

We also request that the signage at the Stony Creek Beach for 15 Minute parking be changed to "Load Unload Only" for the two spots at the south end of the beach.

We have been approached by a few Stony Creek Residents to have more enforcement during the summer of the four and twelve hour parking at the dock. We do have many contractors, visitors and residents who extend their time in these spaces way over the limit.

Last of all in the interest of public safety, we would like to request that the pedestrian crosswalks be painted at the beginning of next years spring and summer, as some were difficult to see this past year. Especially the ones on School Street, at Watrous and School Street and the one going to the Museum at School Street and Thimble Islands.
