# Crime Analysis Report Traffic Crashes & Enforcement

## Thimble Island Road 5-Year Summary

**LOCATION OF ANALYSIS:** Thimble Island Rd., beginning at the Willoughby Wallace Library located at 146 Thimble Island Rd., extending south to the southern Wallace Rd. intersection, an approximate distance of .5 miles.

**TIME PERIOD:** May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014 – May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019

**UNIT OF ANALYSIS:** Motor vehicle crashes and traffic enforcement data, as defined by radar assignments, motor vehicle violations, and citations.

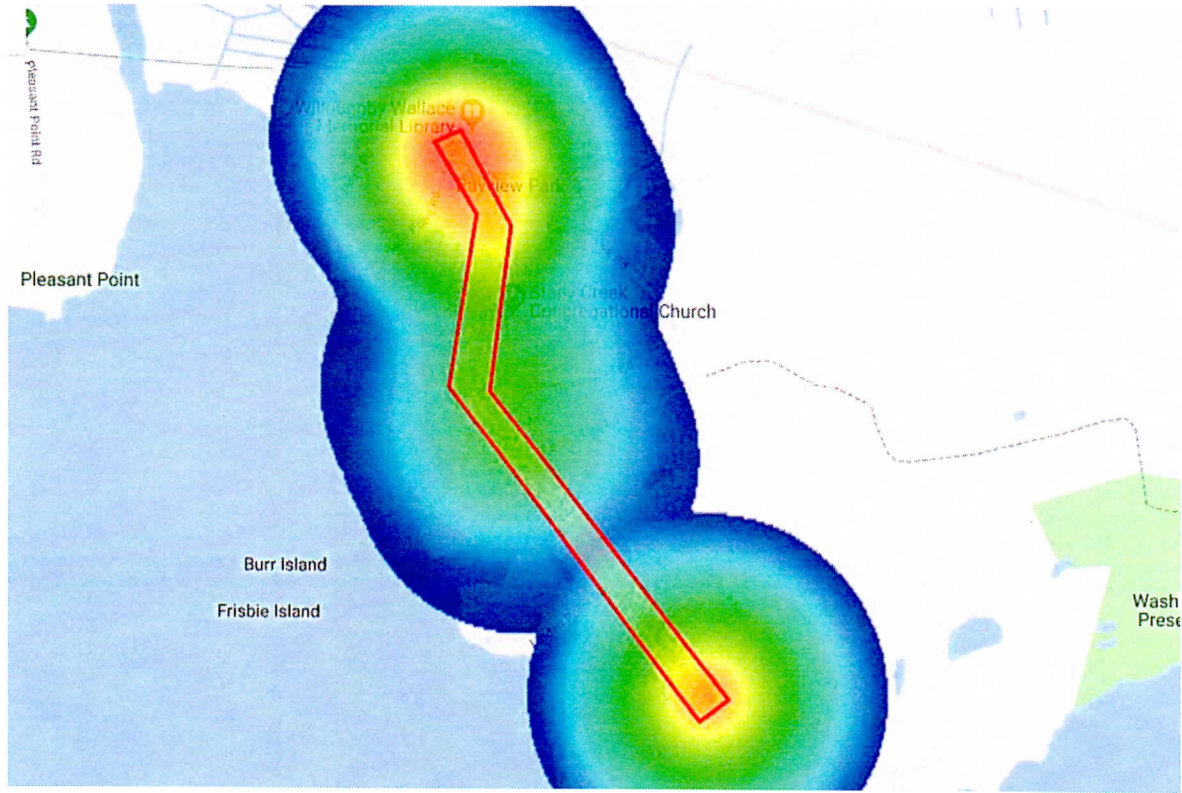
### MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS

An inquiry was conducted for all motor vehicle accidents occurring on Thimble Island Rd. for a 5-year period:

- The search returned a total of **13** motor vehicle accidents.
  - 1 with injuries
  - 9 non-injuries
  - 3 private property
- **Contributing factors were:** Failure to Yield Right-of-Way (1), Failure to Drive Right (1), Driving too Fast for Conditions (1), Distracted Driving (1), Improper Backing (1), Improper Turn (1), and Other (1).
- **August and October** had the greatest number of accidents (3)
  - June had the second greatest amount (2)
- **Sunday** had the most crashes (4)
  - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday each had 2
  - Friday had 1
- **Crashes by Time:**
  - **8 AM to 11 AM:** 4 crashes
  - **1 PM to 3 PM:** 3 crashes
  - **5 PM to 7 PM:** 5 crashes
  - **10 PM to 11 PM:** 1 crash

### ENFORCEMENT



An inquiry was conducted for all motor vehicle accidents occurring on Thimble Island Rd. for a 5-year period:

- Total of **8** incidents
  - Motor Vehicle Violations – 4
  - Radar – 4
- The top reason for MV stops was **Traveling Unreasonably Fast (5)**
  - 3 of these resulted in an Infraction
  - 1 resulted in a Misdemeanor Summons
  - 1 resulted in a Verbal Warning
  - The average speed was 45 MPH
- Following too Closely, Failure to Display Plates, and Improper Turn were the other 3 reasons for MV stops
  - All 3 resulted in verbal warnings
- Consistent with MV Accidents, **August** had the greatest amount of enforcement (3)
  - This was followed by April (2)
- **Sunday (2), Friday (2), and Saturday (2)** had the most enforcement
- Enforcement mostly occurred between **4 PM and 6 PM (4)**
