
Dear Board Members,

Motion to Create the Stony Creek Association Communications Committee

In order to facilitate the timely communication with the Association electorate, a committee of 3 or more board members to be formed to consider the following:

- 1) Updating the Association website, www.sca-ct.org to accommodate the publication of Board proposals, the update of items of crucial importance to the health, comfort and convenience of the community consistent with Sec. 2. of the charter, and to facilitate online surveys as needed to determine the will of the community.**
- 2) Determine a mechanism whereby members of the Board can communicate privately with their constituents consistent with FOIA rules.**
- 3) Explore other outlets for the dissemination of Board information such as Facebook consistent with other local government outlets, e.g., Branford Police Department, Pine Orchard Association, and the Clinton Beach Association.**
- 4) The hiring of professionals to facilitate implementation and maintenance, such as WordPress freelance web developers.**
- 5) Consideration of a mechanism for authorizing updating of content, e.g., Communications Committee review, and who shall have access.**
- 6) Provide a mechanism to publicize results and recommendations of ad-hoc planning groups, such as .**
- 7) Establish an online email path to the webmaster of the Association website.**
- 8) A report of this Committee to be presented to the SCAEB at the September meeting.**
