Motion to Redefine and Extend the Nominations and Elections Standing Committee

The 2014 By-laws state: A Committee on Nominations and Elections, consisting of three or more members, who shall nominate candidates for membership to the Executive Board for election by the membership and handle all matters relating to the annual election.

That the Nominations and Elections Standing Committee actively deliberate for the year with three or more members.

Be it further moved that the duties of the committee shall include the following:

- Conduct surveys of Association members using mailed survey forms, SurveyMonkey or Google Forms soliciting not only their interest in becoming a board member, but their interest in volunteering for various Association/Board functions.
- As a promotional endeavor, highlight the history of the Association on the Association website, what it is, why it exists, who it includes, and as above, how members can be active participants.
- Create a Board Member Information Packet. The packet shall outline the purpose, responsibilities, committees and value standing committee service, beyond and as an elaboration of those outlined in the by-laws.
