This is a Formal FOIA request for the following items relating to the Stony Creek Association and It's Executive Board.

1. Copies or Access of the Zoom recordings for the December 2021 through March 2022 meetings of the Stony Creek Executive Board.
2. List of Attending people for all meetings of the Charter Review Committee , the Stony Creek Day and the Election Committee from December 2021 through June 2022.
3. Copies or access to the meeting minutes and any Zoom type recordings for the committees mentioned in item 2.
4. Documentation of the absentee voting process for the 2022 elections. Including how it meets all CT State rules for anonymity and other issues set forth.
5. Documentation on how the search and vacancy for the replacement of the Beach area cleaner was handled. What is current pay level for this position.
6. List of locations other than public areas designated as parks were provided with funds for flowers/beautification items. Documentation on what the process is to obtain such funds and copies of the receipts for all such payments since September 2021 until June 30, 2022. Also a copy of correspondences with the owners of the locations that were granted funding.
7. Email Addresses used by the SCA to disseminate notices, minutes, agendas etc as of the current date.
8. Details on how concerns of not meeting meeting FOIA requirements were handled and what corrective actions steps were taken during the past year.
9. Process for determining what citizens and how they should be rewarded for the giving of their time to help out the SCA in it's many efforts. List of such recognitions for the 2021- 2022 Association fiscal year, including the cost of such recognitions.
10. Clarity on what meetings for all of the SCA, It's executive board and all associated committees were held in person this year. The agenda for the annual meeting I recieved the
