 - Put up a collection box for the bands.

- Legacy Theatre

 - A performance on stage in the park.
- Create a mural or something for people to decorate and kids to color that can go on a wall afterwards.
- **Parade**
 - Start location for the parade – either the fire house or around the memorial triangle.
 - Give prizes for parade floats
 - Include antique cars
 - The Stony Creek Fife and Drum Corp cannot attend. It is the same day as their golf tournament fundraiser.
 - We will have to pay police officers.
- **Merchandise**
 - We have lots of sling bags and kids tshirts to sell.
 - We want to have a new shirt design this year. Jennifer Walker designed something for the Museum last year that may be good. She is willing to share her design a little but wants to redesign them a bit and sign it. Maybe on white tshirts.

- **Logistics**

 - We need to advertise a lot more this year.
 - We were told we can use the town's new stage.

 - Maybe do a google sheet also

 - We will ask the SCA for sponsor money as well. Our current balance is just under \$3,000.
